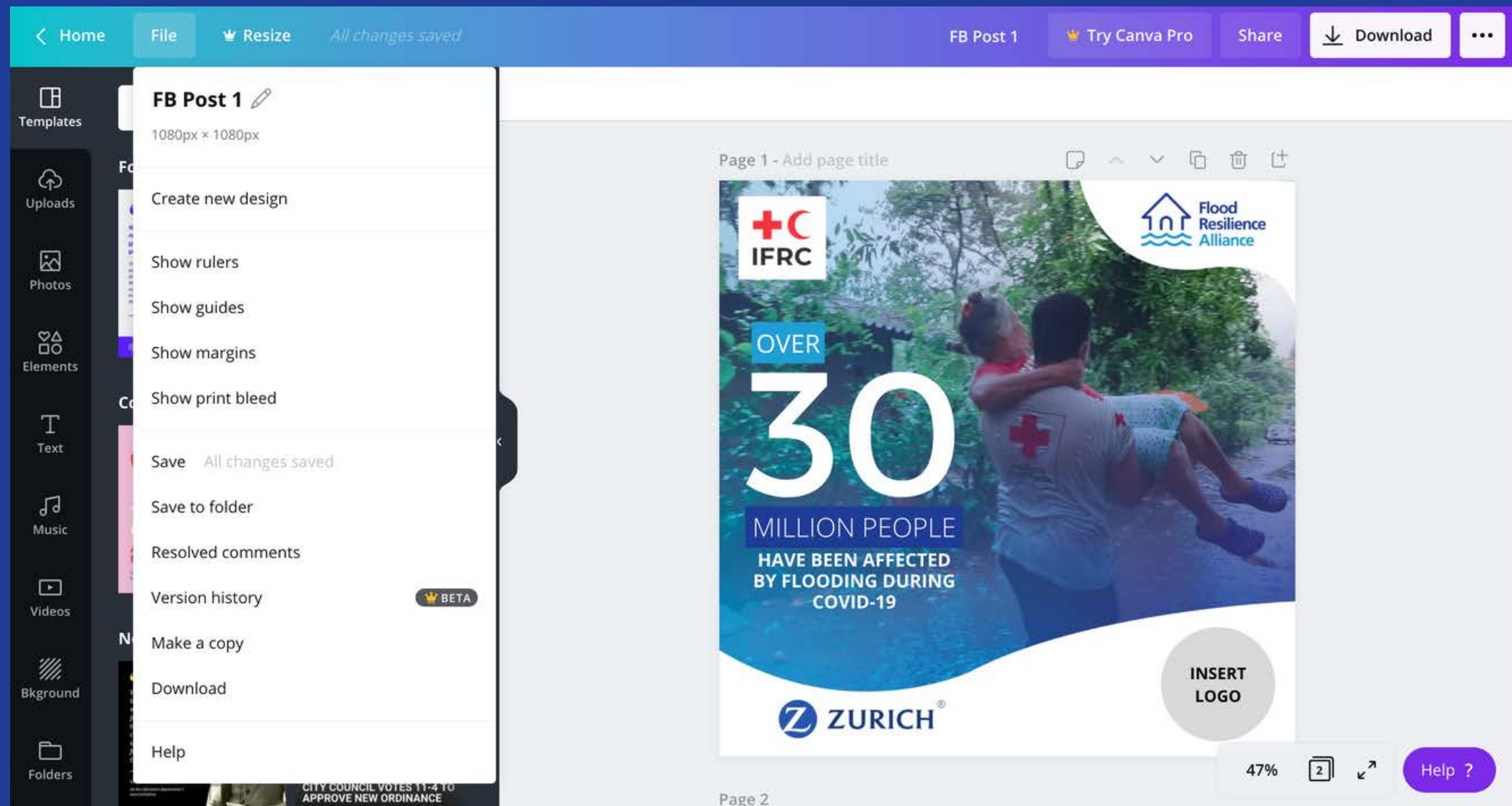

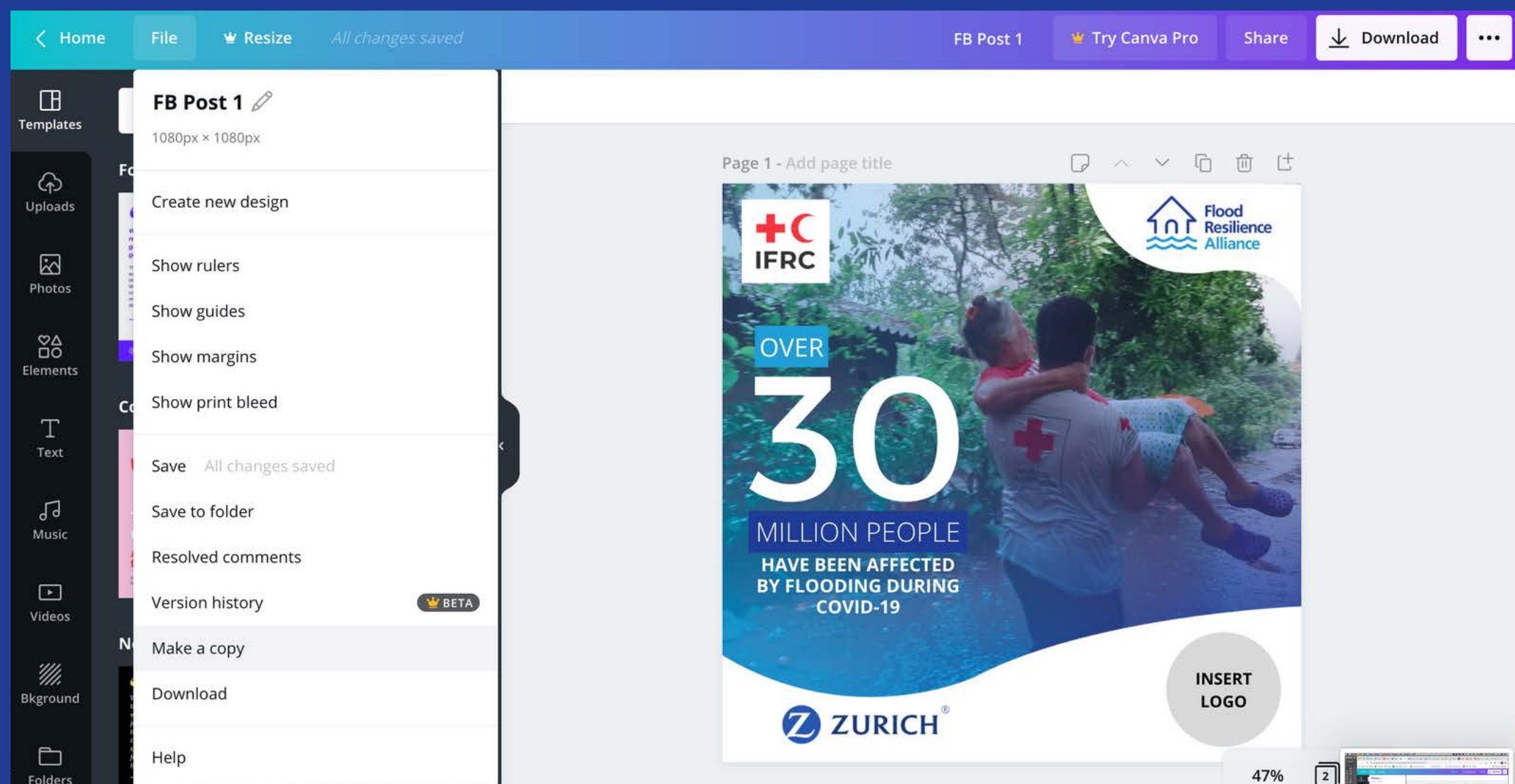

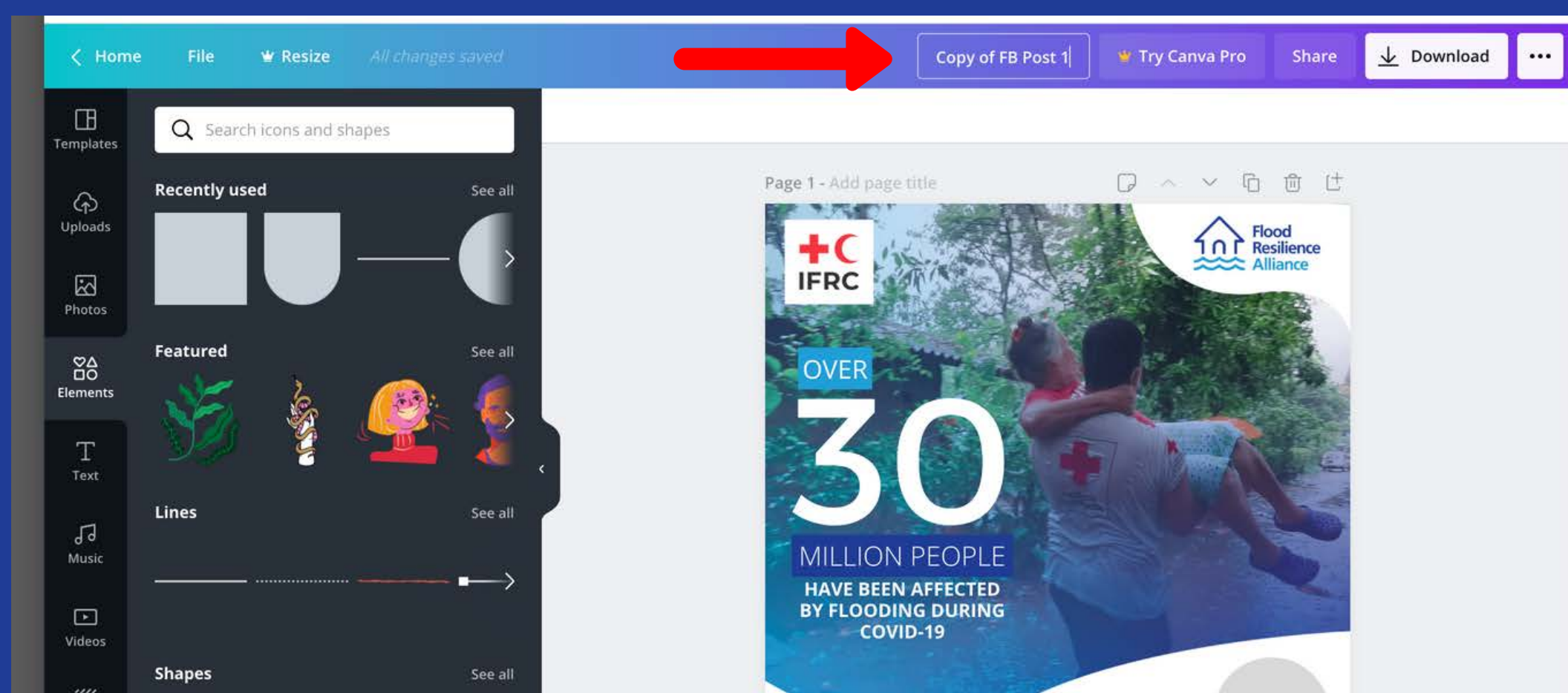

Maintain communication with neighbours especially the elderly and disabled persons.

Keep hazardous chemicals above anticipated flood levels.

Avoid looking for shelter or traveling on foot at night if there has been flood impact.

Avoid touching electrical items that may be wet or has been in contact with water.

Keep important documents and papers above potential flood levels, using waterproof containers where possible.

Speak with local authorities to find out more about the evacuation plans of your neighbourhood.

Identify the safe evacuation routes out of your home if necessary.

Monitor the weather closely, whether there is a flood watch or flood warning in place.

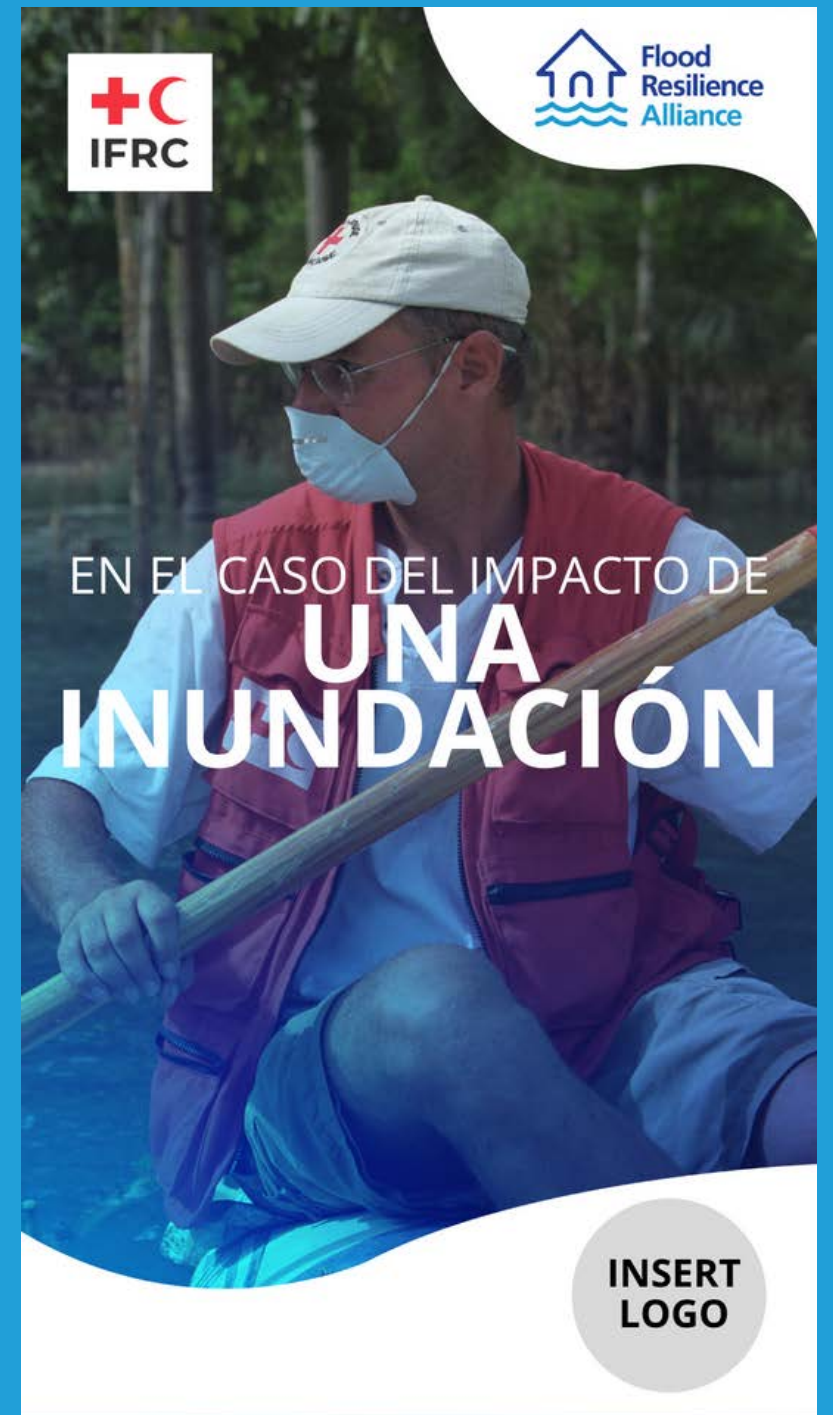
