Baseline: COVID-19 Perception Survey

Date:

February - March 15, 2023

Enumerators:

10 volunteers from each chapter

Target Communities:

lowest COVID-19 vaccination rate







Methodology & Sample Demographics







Methodology


- Household surveys were conducted face-to-face by the volunteers during
 1 Feb to 15 Mar 2023
- PRC chapters determined the target communities
- A representative sample of households were randomly selected based on the geographical information system (GIS) data (i.e., <u>WorldPop Global</u>) integrated into <u>gridsample.org</u>
- A two-stage cluster sampling were implemented where a few neighborhood grids were selected within each target community and 20 households were selected within each neighborhood by systematic sampling
- Respondents have different probabilities of being selected depending on the estimated population size and response rate of each sampled neighborhood, hence, a sampling weight was calculated for each respondent
- The sampling weight was further adjusted by rebalancing according to gender ratio (i.e., 49.8% females vs. 50.2% males according to the Philippine census 2021 estimate)







- Weighted sample size: 2,757 (1,387 males, 1,354 females, 15 others)
- Scope: target communities of low COVID-19 vaccination rates in Albay, Cotabato, Lanao del Sur, Masbate, Sulu, Surigao del Norte, and Tawi-Tawi
- 96% of the communities reside in rural areas
- 28% reported having a chronic illness ((i.e., heart disease, diabetes, asthma, kidney disease, obesity, cancer etc.)
- 24% reported their family have received aid from PRC

















Risk Perception

How concerned are you about getting COVID-19?










Preventive Measures

What measures do you find most important to protect yourself front he virus






How much do you trust the COVID-19 vaccine?













Since getting vaccinated against COVID-19, which COVID-19 public health measures do you follow?




